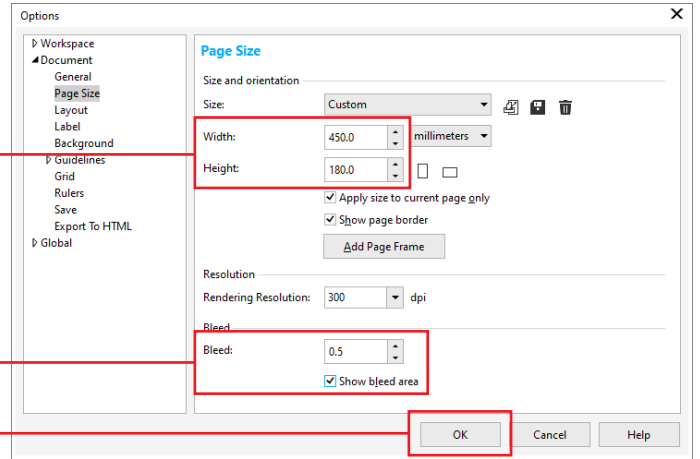
Setting up artwork at 10%

STEP 1 - Create a new document

Go to File > New
Go to Layout > Page Setup
Enter size at 10%

Enter 0.5mm Bleed (5mm Bleed at 100%)
Check Show bleed area
Click OK

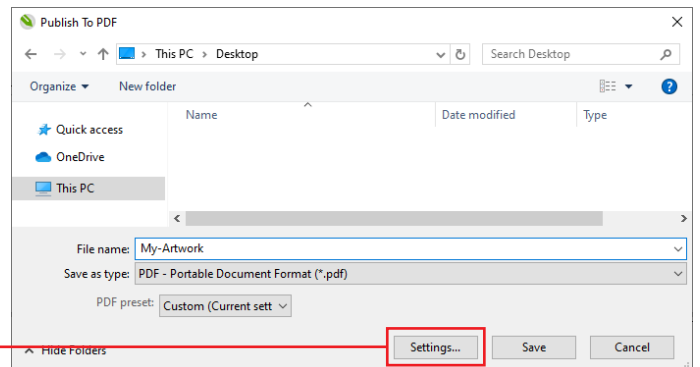


STEP 2 - DESIGN YOUR ARTWORK

STEP 3 - Publish To PDF

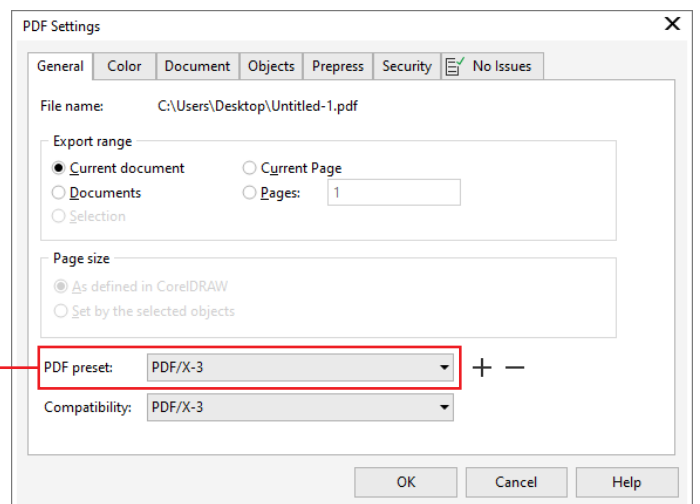
Go to File > Publish to PDF

Click Settings...



STEP 4 - PDF Settings - General

Select PDF preset: PDF/X-4 or PDF/X-3

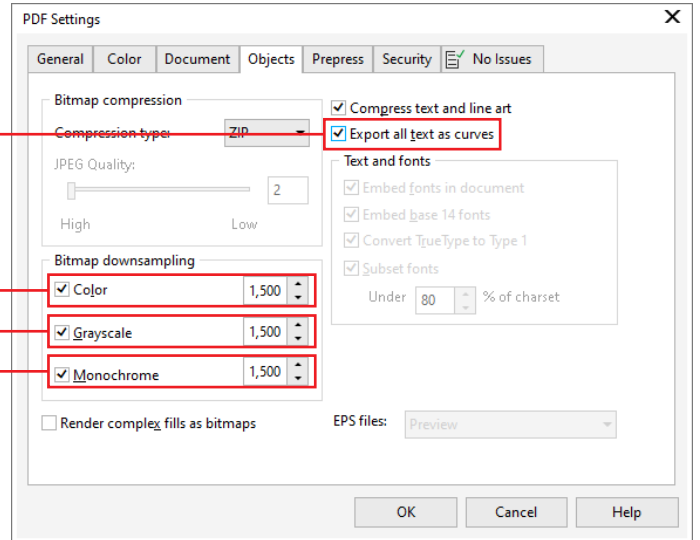
STEP 5 - PDF Settings - Objects

Check Export all text as curves

Enter 1500

Enter 1500

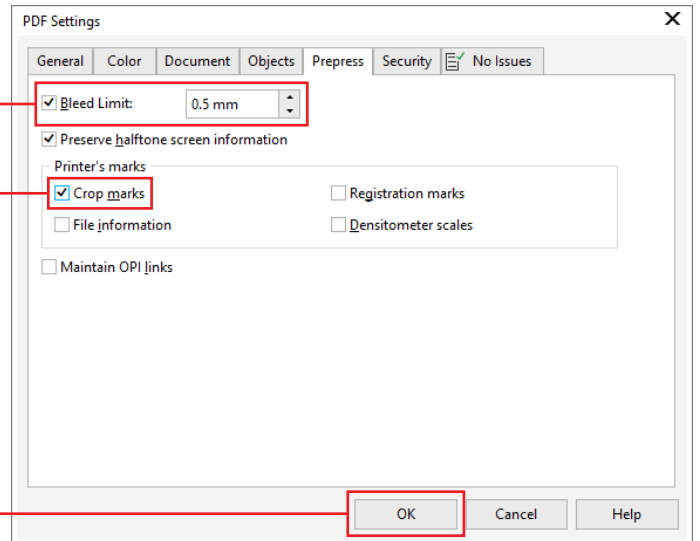


STEP 6 - PDF Settings - Prepress

Check Bleed Limit and set to 0.5mm

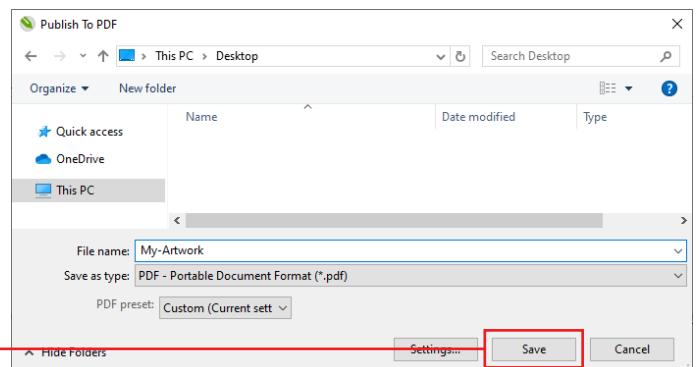
Check Crop marks

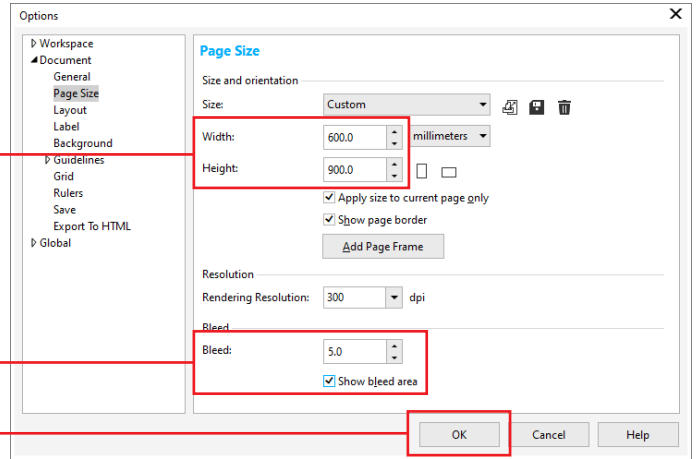

Click OK

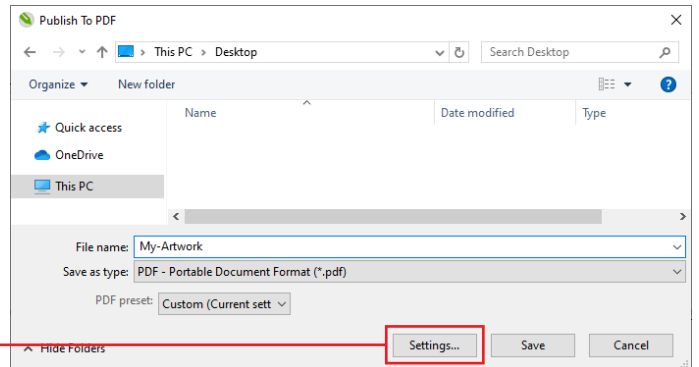

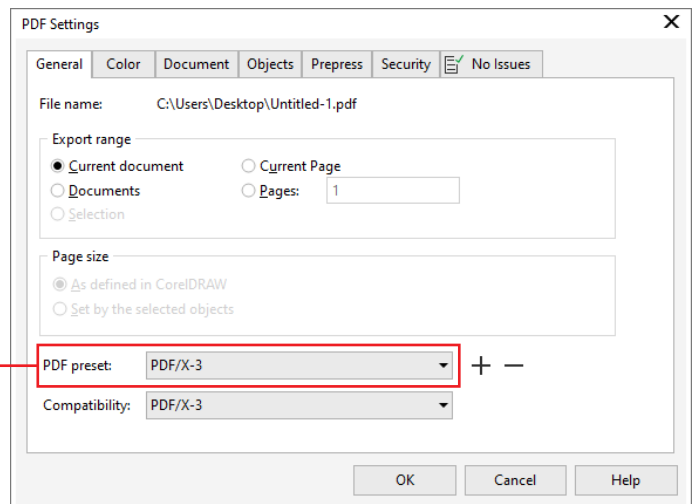
Go to File > Publish to PDF

Select PDF preset: PDF/X-4 or PDF/X-3



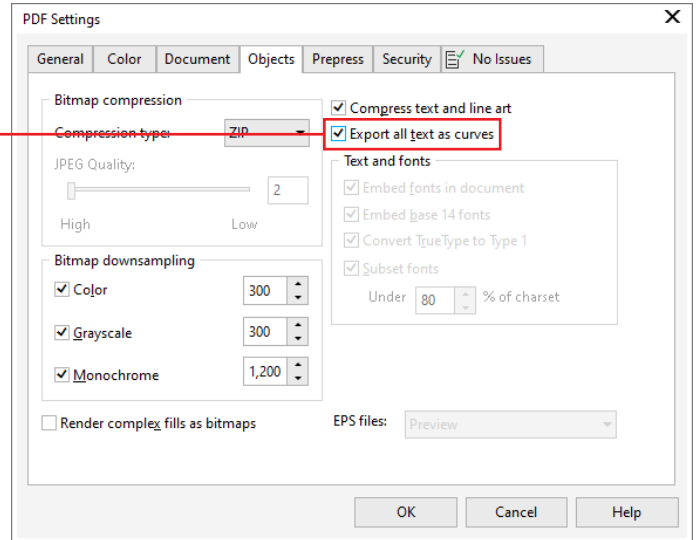

STEP 5 - PDF Settings - Objects

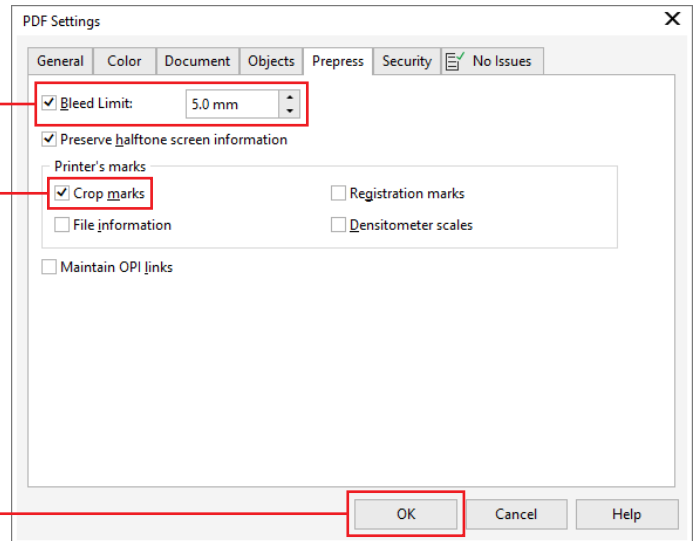
Check Export all text as curves



STEP 6 - PDF Settings - Prepress

Check Bleed Limit and set to 5.0mm

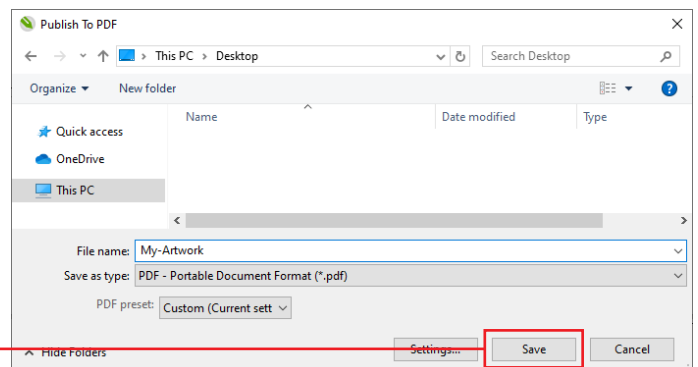
Check Crop marks
